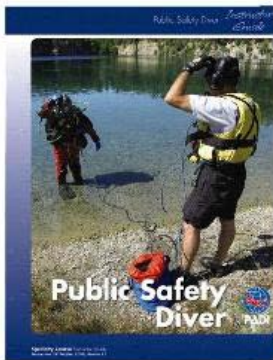




ABOUT MIKE

The Underwater Criminal Investigators Course

This foundational course is designed to give you the knowledge, skills, and abilities to succeed and survive as a true professional underwater criminal investigator.



32-hours of hands-on intensive training that involves one day of lecture and three days of open water training.

Topics include: Readiness, Establishing a Crime Scene, Interviewing, Crime Scene Photography and Sketching, Communications, Medical Aspects, Search Patterns, Locating and Marking Evidence, Evidence Recovery and Preservation, Fingerprints, Body Movement in Water, Body Recovery, Chemical and Polluted Water, Light and Heavy Salvage, Vehicle Recovery, Case Preparation, Courtroom Testimony and more!

The “Master’s Program”

UCI’s Master Underwater Criminal Investigator Program is the only course of its kind in the world



and is UCI’s advanced training program designed to focus on several areas of Public Safety Diving that

need to be truly understood and mastered. The Master UCI course builds on the skills acquired in the UCI course and takes these skills to an advanced level. Students are trained and certified as:

- **Body Recovery Specialist**
- **Vehicle Recovery Specialist**
- **Evidence Recovery Specialist**
- **Crime Scene Metal Detector Specialist**

Special Note: Each course can be taught separately in a 1-day format

After completing the 5-day course, the students are certified in all four additional specialties as well as being awarded the coveted **PADI Master Underwater Criminal Investigator** license. If that isn’t enough, as a certified Rescue Diver you qualify for the PADI Master Diver rating as well.
